

## Survey No. 2617.

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The N.W. Cor. Sec. 36, T.2S. R.42E. M.D.M. to which connection is herein given consists of a stone showing 8x8x18 ins. above ground chiselled 1 notch on south and 1 notch on east sides and x on top.

Cor. No. 2. Sur. No. 2610 Missouri Grandpa lode. consists of a post 4 ins. square, showing 2-1/2 ft. above ground scribed 2-2610

Cor. Nos. 4 Sur. No. 2564 Laguna and Miss Jessie lodes consists of a post 4 ins. square, showing 2-1/2 ft. above ground scribed 4-4-2564.

Cor. No. 3 Sur. No. 2610 Black Rock lode consists of a post 4 ins. square, showing 2-1/2 ft. above ground scribed 3-2610.

Cor. No. 3 Sur. No. 2564 Last Chance lode consists of a post 4 ins. square, showing 2 ft. above ground scribed 3-2564.

The N.W. Cor. Kewana Fraction lode (unsurveyed) consists of a post 4 ins. square, showing 3-1/2 ft. above ground marked N.W. Cor. Kewana Fraction lode.

Cor. Nos. 4-3 Surs. Nos. 2323 and 2431 Night Hawk and Booth lodes consists of a post 4 ins. square, showing 2-1/2 ft. above ground in mound scribed 4-2323 and 3-2431.

Cor. No. 4 Sur. No. 2324 East Side lode consists of a post 4 ins. square showing 2-1/2 ft. above ground scribed 4-2324.

All intersecting and common lines of the conflicting and adjoining claims were found upon the ground as given in the foregoing field notes.

The intersections with Section lines were calculated from the returns of the public land survey.
