The $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor. between Secs. 24 and 19 Tp. 28 S. Rg. 60 and 61 E. respectively, Mt. Diablo Base and Mer. is a cedar stake about 3 ins. diameter 2 ft. long above ground, set in a mound of stone and earth and scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ S. on the West side.

Cor. No. 5 Sur. No. 2597 Col Sellers lode is a pine post 4 ins. square set in a mound of stone 4 ft. base 2 ft. high from which it extends above about 12 ins. scribed 5-2597 on the easterly side.
