

Survey No.2680

REPORT.

- 1st. The lines of this survey and the connections to other surveys and to the corner of the Public Land Survey were run upon the ground.
- 2nd. **Sur.No.37 B Aultman Millsite.**
Corners No's 2 & 4 are pine posts 4 ins. square, 3 ft. above ground in mounds of earth and stone, scribed 2-37 B and 4-37 B respectively.
- Sur.No.41 Millsite.**
All corners of this survey are missing, their positions were determined by the tie given in the approved field notes from Cor.No.1 to Cor.No.1 Sur.No.37 B.Aultman Millsite.
- Sur.No.44 Isaacs lode.**
Cor.No.1 is a pine post 4 ins. square, 3 ft. above ground in mound of stone, scribed 1-44.
- Sur.No.57 Commodore lode.**
Cor.No.3 is a pine post 4 ins. square, 3 ft. above ground in mound of stone, scribed 3-57.
- Sur.No.65 Turkey lode.**
Cor.No.11 of this survey is a pine post 4 ins. square, 3 ft. above ground, scribed 11-U.S.S.65.
From Cor.No.10, Cor.No.6 Sur.No.2680 set identical with the location of the Cor. common to Sections 12 and 13 T. 16 N.R.62 E. and Secs.7 and 18 T.16 N.R.63 E.Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, bears N.1°29'40"W. 589.73 ft. instead of N.3°15'W. 592.0 ft as given in the approved field notes.
- Sur.No.1725 Rob Roy lode.**
Cor.No.4 of this survey is missing. Cor.No.3 is a pine post 4 ins. square, 3 ft. above ground and scribed 3-1725.
From Cor.No.1, Cor.No.6 of Sur.No.2680 set identical with the location of the Corner common to Secs.12 and 13 T.16 N.R.62 E. and Secs.7 and 18 T.16 N.R.63 E.Mount Diablo Base and Meridian bears N.8°58'20"W. 1316.15 ft. instead of N.9°16'W. 1334.2 ft. as given in the approved field notes.
- 3rd. The S.1/4 Cor. Sec.12 T.16 N.R.62 E.Mount Diablo Base and Meridian is a lime stone marked 1/4 on the north face and set in a mound of stone.
The corner common to Sections 1 and 12 T.16 N.R.62 E. and 6 and 7 T.16 N.R.63 E.Mount Diablo Base and Meridian is a lime stone 12" above ground in a mound of stone, 5 grooves on south and 1 groove on north face.
The corner common to Sections 13 and 24 T. 16 N.R.62 E. and 18 and 19 T.16 N.R.63 E.Mount Diablo Base and Meridian is a lime stone 14" above ground in a mound of stone, marked with 3 grooves on south and 3 on the north face.
