DESCRIPTION OF CORNERS.

The $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor. on the West boundary of Sec. 23, T. 23 N., R. 62 E. of the Mt. Dia. Base and Meridian, is a quartzite rock, 6 x 6 ins., 12 ins. high in mound of stone marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on South face.

The N.W. Cor. of Sec. 23, T. 23 N., R. 62 E. of the Mt. Dia. Base and Meridian is a quartzite rock 8 x 9 ins., 12 ins. high, in mound of stone, with three notches on South face, and two notches on East face.

Note: From the $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor. on the West boundary of Sec. 23, the N.W. Cor. of said Section bears N. $0^{\circ}02'E$. 2677.3 ft.
