 DESCRIPTION OF CORNERS.

The Corner of Sections 14, 15, 22 and 23, T. 23 N. R. 62 E. of the Mt. Dia. B. and M. is a quartzite rock 8 x 9 ins., 12 ins. high in monument of stone, with 3 notches on the south face, and 2 notches on the East face.

Survey No. 2165, Gold Nuggett Lode:

Cor. No. 3 is a pine post, 4 ins. square, $7\frac{1}{2}$ ft. above the ground, firmly set in monument of stone, scribed No. 3 USS 2165.

Survey No. 2698 A, Ball Hill Johny Lode:

Cor. No. 4 is a pine post, $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. long, 4 ins. square 2 ft. above ground in mound of stone, scribed 4-2698 A.

Survey No. 2698 B, Bull Hill Johnnie Mill Site:

Cor. No. 1 is a pine post, $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. long, 4 ins. square, 2 ft. high in mound of stone, scribed 1-2698 B.

Cor. No. 4 is a pine post, $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. long, 4 ins. square, 2 ft. above ground in mound of earth, scribed 4-2698 B.

Survey No. 2697 B. Olympia Mill Site:

Cor. No. 1 is a sawed pine post, 4 ins. square in mound of earth 2 ft. above ground, scribed 1-2697 B.
