No. 1, The discovery shaft 4 x 6 ft 20 ft. deep all in rock the center of which bears from Cor. No. 7, S. 66° E., 715.00 ft.

No. 2. A shaft 4 x 6 ft., 55 ft. deep, all in rock, the center of which bears from Cor. No. 7, S. 56° 45' E. 900.00 ft.

Value-----\$550.00

INSTRUMENT.

This survey was made with a Buff and Berger Mountain Transit. The corners were deflected from the true meridian as determined by an observation on Polaris at its western elongation. The distances were measured with 500 and 100 ft. steel tapes.

S U R F A C E

The surface embraced by this claim is low rolling hills, void of timber and other natural objects for bearings.

Note:- The difference between length and course of lode line of this survey and the Location Certificate is due to errors in the latter, the boundaries of this survey being identical with the location.

REPORT:- The monument marking the Cor. to Secs. 2 and 3, Tp. 29-S., R. 63-E., M.D.M. is a rock 12 x 12 ins. 20 ins. above the ground in a mound of stone and earth, chiseled two notches East, four West and six South.
