The ground from the mouth of this shaft rises rapidly toward the Elaine, Pyramid Fraction, Crosscut and Crosscut Extension lodes of this survey, which are from 100 ft. to 250 ft. higher than the mouth of the shaft.

The drifts from the 950 ft. level as described under estimate of expenditure No. 5, will if continued in their present course, cut the lodes at great depth, whereby by one system of workings and one plant of machinery, the entire claim can be most economically and advantageously developed.

## INSTRUMENT.

This survey was made with a Buff and Buff mountain transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined from an observation on Polaris at elongation. The distances were measured with a 660 ft. and 6 ft. steel tapes.
