Cor. No.8 Sur. No. 2565 Kewana No.3 lode consists of
a post, 4 ins. square, showing $2\frac{1}{2}$ ft. above ground
scribed 8-2565.

Cor. No.3, Sur. No. 2228, Lazy George lode, consists
of a post 4 ins. square, showing $2\frac{1}{2}$ ft. above ground.
scribed 3-2228.

The N.W. Cor. ^{unsurveyed} Potlach lode consists of a post 4 ins.
square, showing 3 ft. above ground marked N.W. Cor.
Potlach lode.
