

SURVEY No. 2840.

INSTRUMENT.

This survey was made with a C. L. Berger and Sons Light Mountain Transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined from direct solar observations. The distances were measured with 6 ft. and 500 ft. steel tapes.

NOTE.

The disagreements between these field notes and the location certificate is due to errors in the latter.

REPORT.

The W. $\frac{1}{4}$ Cor. of Sec. 30 T. 2 S. R. 43 E. M.D.B. and M. is a stone 6"X7 inches standing 10 inches above ground chiseled $\frac{1}{4}$.

Cor. No. 1 Sur. No. 2226 Overlook lode is a pine post 4 ins. square, standing 2 ft. above mound of stone, scribed 1-2226.

Cor. No. 2 Sur. No. 2277 Vindicator No. 4 lode is a pine post 4 ins. square, standing 2 ft. above ground scribed 2-2277.
