INSTRUMENT.

This survey was made with a Gurley Light Mountain Transit. The courses were deflected from the true Meridian as determined by solar observation.

Distances were measured with a 6 and 500 ft. steel tape.

NOTE:--The disagreements between these field notes and the location certificate are due to errors in the latter.

REPORT.

All lines of this survey and the ties to conflicting claims and the tie to the corner of the public survey were made direct upon the ground.

The $W \frac{1}{4}$ Cor. Sec. 34, T. 3 N. R. 42 E., is a porphyry stone 4x8 ins 8 ins. above the general surface, marked $\frac{1}{4}$.
