

SURVEY NO. 2918.

No. 6. A Shaft, 4 x 6 ft., 150 ft. deep in earth and rock, first 16 ft. timbered, the center of which bears from Cor. No. 2 Clara lode, N. 9° 30' W. 408.5 ft.

Value \$1500.00.

No. 7. A Drift, 4 x 6 ft., 73 ft. long in rock, which is driven East from the bottom of shaft described under im-

provement No. 6.

Value \$730.00.

The Shaft described under improvement No. 6, is located upon the line between the Dew Drop and Clara lodes.

A one half undivided interest in this shaft is applied upon each of the lodes of this survey.

The remaining improvements are applied upon the claim upon which they are located.

OTHER IMPROVEMENTS.

A frame dwelling the S. W. Cor. of which bears from Cor. No. 2 Dew Drop lode, N. 22° 15' E. 260 ft., 24 x 26 ft., course of long sides N. 13° 30' E. claimant unknown.

A frame dwelling the S. W. Cor. of which bears from Cor. No. 1 Clara lode N. 31° 45' W. 368 ft., 30 x 32.6 ft., course of long sides N. 10° W. owned by G. S. Phenix.

INSTRUMENT.

This survey was made with a Brandis Son and Co. Light Mountain Transit.

The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observations upon the sun.

The distances were measured with 660 ft. and 100 ft. steel tapes.
