

## SURVEY NO. 2962

Improvement No. 2 AfterThought Lode is in course of construction for the development of the entire lode claim. A cross-cut from this shaft running in a southerly direction will cut the Quick Relief Vein at great depth. In this way one system of workings and one plant of machinery can be used to develop the entire claim in a most advantageous and economical manner. An undivided one-half interest in this improvement is credited to the Quick Relief and After Thought lodes.

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 ✓ OTHER IMPROVEMENTS.

There are no other improvements on this claim.

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 ✓ I N S T R U M E N T

This Survey was made with a Keuffel and Esser Light Mountain Transit. The courses were deflected from the True Meridian as determined by an observation on Polaris at elongation. The distances were measured with 500 ft. and 100 ft. steel tapes.

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S U R F A C E.

The surface embraced in this survey is low, steep hills with a general incline in a northerly direction, void of all vegetation except scattered bunches of greasewood and of all natural objects for bearings.

Note:- The differences between these field notes and the location certificates are due to errors in the latter.

REPORT:- The Standard Corner to Secs. 31 and 32, Tp. 23-S., R. 64-E., M.D.M. reported in this Survey, is a dark colored rock 6 x 12 inches, 15 inches above the ground in mound of rock, chiselled 5 notches East and 1 notch West.
