

Expenditure of Five Hundred Dollars
 I certify that the value of the labor and improvements upon this claim, placed thereon by the claimant and his grantors is less than five hundred dollars for each location and that said improvements consist of:

The discovery tunnel of the Midnight lode the mouth of which bears from cor. no. 3 $S. 23^{\circ} 55' E.$ 435 ft. and runs thence east 90 ft. 4x6 ft. to breast.

Value \$900.

The discovery shaft of the Storm Cloud lode which bears from cor. no. 2 $N. 13^{\circ} 40' E.$ 666 ft. 6x10 ft. 8 ft. deep.

Value \$108.

The discovery shaft of the no name lode which bears from cor. no. 1 $N. 29^{\circ} 30' W.$ 584 ft. 4x6 ft. 10 ft. deep.

Value \$107.

The discovery cut of the Midnight Fraction lode, the mouth of which bears from cor. no. 1 $N. 37^{\circ} W.$ 178 ft. running thence east 14 ft. 4 ft. wide to breast 10 ft. high.

Value \$121.

Other Improvements

The surveys of the Midnight, Storm Cloud, No Name and Midnight Fraction lodes are identical with the respective amended locations.

Instrument

This survey was made with a Gurley Light Mountain Transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observations. The distances were measured with a 400 ft. steel tape.

No local ties were available.

Report.

The S.E. cor. sec. 32 Tp. 5 S. R. 40 E. Mt. Diablo B. and M. to which ties are given is a porphyry stone showing above ground 14x10x9 ins, in mound of stones marked 11 on West side and 1111 on east side.
