INSTRUMENT.

This Survey was made with a Leitz Light mountain
 transit with Saegmuller Solar attachment.

The courses were deflected from the true meridian
 as determined with the Saegmuller Solar attachment.

The distances were measured with 50ft. and 500 ft.
 steel tapes.

NOTE: The disagreements between these field notes and
 the location certificates are due to errors in the latter.

REPORT.

S. W. Cor. Sec. 26, T. 13 N., R. 24'E., M. D. B/ and
 M. is a quartzite stone 12 x 10 x 8 ins., set in the
 ground in mound of stone, with 1 notch on south and 2
 notches on east edges.

Cor. No. 3-4 Sur. No. 1990 Morning Star and Relief
 lodes is a pine post 4 ins. square and projects 3 ft. above
 a mound of earth and stone, scribed 3-4-1990.

Cor. No. 3, Sur. No. 2753, Ludwig No. 3 lode is a
 pine post 4 ins. square showing 2 ft. above ground, scribed
 3-2753.

Cor. No. 2 Sur. No. 1990 Azurite^{Mine} lode is a pine post
 4 ins. square showing 2 ft. above a mound of earth, scribed
 2-1990.

The N. W. Cor. Marion lode (unsurveyed) is a pine
 post 4 ins. square projecting 2 ft. above a mound of
 earth and stone scribed N. W. Marion.

The S. E. Cor. Copper Queen NO. 3 lode (unsurveyed)
 is a pine post 4 ins. square projecting 18 ins. above
 a mound of earth scribed S. E. Copper Queen 3.
