No.16. The location work of the Texas lode, consisting of an open cut, the face of which, bears from the location monument, S.60°59'W. 15 ft. 12 ft. face, 4 ft. wide, running S.8°E. 24 ft. to surface.

This survey was made with a No.4 Buff and Berger transit.

The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observations.

The distances were measured with a 500 ft. steel tape.

The S.E. Cor. Sec. 25, T. 13 N. R. 24E.M.D.M. consists of a stone 5x12x12 ins. in mound of rock, marked 1 notch on South, and 5 notches on north edge.

Cor. No.3, Sur. No.2913, Yellowstone lode, consists of a pine post, 4x6 ins. showing 2½ ft. above ground in mound scribed 3-2913.
