

were deflected from the true meridian as determined by solar observation.

Distances were measured with a 100 and 500 ft. steel tape.

NOTE:- The disagreements between these field notes and the location certificates are due to errors in the latter.

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REPORT.

The N. E. Cor. Sec. 12, T. 3 S. R. 42 E., M.D.B. and M. is a stone 7x9x6 ins. above ground, chiseled 1 notch on the north and 5 notches on the south.

All corners of conflicting surveys are posts correctly marked with their respective corner and survey numbers.

The bearing of line 2-3 Sur. No. 2719 Golden Horse Shoe Lode, is N. 2° 33' E., instead of N 2° 48' E., as approved.

The corners of conflicting surveys referred to above are posts 4 ins. square, standing 3 ft. above mounds of earth and stone.
