Other Improvements

The first 45 ft. of shaft described under improvements No. 1. Claimants unknown.

A mill building, the N. E. Cor. of which bears from Cor. No. 1, Crescent mill site $S. 81^{\circ} 15' E.$ 270 ft., the boundaries running from said N. E. Cor. as follows: — $S. 42^{\circ} E. 102$ ft.; thence $S. 48^{\circ} W. 32$ ft.; thence $N. 42^{\circ} W. 70$ ft.; thence $S. 48^{\circ} W. 28$ ft.; thence $N. 42^{\circ} W. 32$ ft.; thence $N. 48^{\circ} E. 60$ ft.

Inside this building is an 8 stamp mill, owned by claimant herein.

A pump house, the S. W. Cor. of which bears from Cor. No. 1, Crescent mill site $N. 71^{\circ} 30' E. 180$ ft. 12×16 ft. Course of long sides Northeast. Owned by claimant herein.

Instrument.

This survey was made with a Buff & Buff No. 4 transit. The courses were determined by direct solar observations. The distances were measured with a 500 ft. steel tape.

Note: — The disagreements between these field notes and the location certificates of the several locations are due to errors in the latter.

Report: — The ties to the N. E. Cor. of Sec. 17, were calculated through Sur. No. 3018 A. & B. made by me. Said section corner is a lava rock 6×10 ins, showing 12 inches above ground with four notches on South and East sides. The E. & W. Cor. and S. E. Cor. of said section could not be found.
