REPORT:-The Government Corner reported in this survey as Cor. to Secs. 26,27,34 and 35, Tp. 28-S., R. 63-E., M.D.M. is a ^{dark} colored rock 10 x 12 inches 12 ins. above the ground with mound of rock, chiseled 2 notches East and 2 Notches South.

The following corners mentioned in this survey are all marked by pine posts 4 ins. square, set 2-1/2 ft. above a mound of stone and earth:-

✓ Cor. No. 6 and 3, Quaker Girl and Domestic lodes respectively of Survey No. 2624, scribed 6-3-2624;

✓ Cor. No. 1 and 4 Barney Riely and Quaker Girl lodes, respectively, of Survey No. 2624, scribed 4-1-2624;

✓ Cor. No. 5 Barney Riely Lode, Survey No. 2624, scribed 5-2624;

✓ Cor. No. 4 Survey No. 2624 Barney Riely lode and No.5 Survey No. 2605, Santa Fe lode, respectively, is scribed 4-2624 and 5-2605.

✓ Cor. No. 1 Survey No.2605, Santa Fe Lode, scribed 1-2605

✓ Cor. No. 4, Survey No. 2605, Telluride Lode is scribed 4-2605.
