

## Survey No. 3055.

## Instrument.

This survey was made with a Lietz light mountain transit, the courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observation. The distances were measured with 500ft. and 50ft. steel tapes.

## Note.

The disagreements between these field notes and the location certificate with regard to the position of the location corners and courses of boundary lines is due to errors in the latter.

## Report.

The  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. Cor., Secs.  $\frac{27}{34}$ , T 13 N. R 24 E. Mt. Diablo B. and M., to which this survey is tied, consists of a rock, 12 ins. x 10 ins. x 8 ins. marked with a cross on top and " $\frac{1}{4}$ " on the side, beside a large rock 30 ins. high x 15 ins. x 12 ins., standing in a mound of rocks.
