

No. 3 Main working shaft, 4-1/2 x 10 ft., 610 ft. deep,

An undivided one-half interest in this main
 working shaft is credited to the McNamara lode
 of this survey, and an undivided one-half interest
 to the McNamara Extension lode of this survey.

The entire claim can be most advantageously and
 economically developed through this shaft, which
 cuts the vein, common to the two lodes of this
 survey, at a depth of three hundred feet.

The other improvements above mentioned are credited
 to the respective locations on which they are located.

The surface embraced in this claim slopes from the
 southwest corner of the McNamara Extension lode to-
 ward the Northeast corner of the McNamara lode, the
 difference in the elevation of said corners being
 about thirty feet.
