The corner to Sec's. 9, 10, 15 & 16, is
a rock, 15 x 12 ins. 6 ins. above the
ground marked with 4 notches
on the S. and 2 notches on the E.
edges with a mound of stones
along side

Cors. N^o 1 and 2 Lot N^o 54 Great
Eastern lode are sawed pine posts
4 ins. square, extending 2½ ft.
above the ground in a mound
of earth and stones scribed U.S.
T. 1-54 and U.S.P. 2-54 respectively.

No corners of Lot N^o 40 Veritas
Tunnel lode and Lot N^o 53 Veritas
lode could be found, so I
determined their position by
calculation through official tie
given to Cor. of Sec's. 9, 10, 15 & 16,
T. 31 N., R. 43 E., M. D. M.
