

Additional and Amended Survey No. 3084.
Little Gem Lode.

Cor. No. 1.

A pine post $4\frac{1}{2}$ ft. long, 4 ins. square, set 18 ins. in the ground in mound of earth and stone, scribed 1-3084. Exact cor. point indicated by nail in top of post, whence, -

The cor. of secs. 3, 4, 9 and 10, T. 28 N., R. 47 E., Mt. Diablo Base and Meridian bears $N. 86^{\circ} 42' E.$ 9283.05 ft. distant.

Location.

This claim is located in the north-west quarter of sec. 8, T. 28 N., R. 47 E., Mt. Diablo Base and Meridian.

Instrument.

This additional and amended survey was executed with a W. and L. E. Gurley engineer's transit. The true meridian was determined by direct solar observation. The distances were measured with a 500 ft. steel tape graduated to feet and with a 25 ft. steel tape graduated to hundredths of a foot.

Report.

The sec. cor. common to secs. 3, 4, 9 and 10, to which connection is given in these notes, consists of a granite boulder 10 by 9 by 8 ins., marked with 3 notches on the east side and 5 notches on the south side and is set 5 ins. in the ground with mound alongside 4 ins. above the general level of the ground. The mound shows evidences of having been washed away to a considerable extent.
