

FINAL OATHS OF ASSISTANTS.

Survey No. 3103

Sur. No. 38 Crescent lode.

All corners of this survey are missing. The position of Cor. No. 4 was determined from the tie given in the approved field notes of Sur. No. 39 Golden Eagle lode.

Sur. No. 40 B. Hamptons Placer.

Cor. No. 6 is a pine post 4 ins. square 3 ft. above ground in a mound of stone, scribed U.S. 40-No. 6

3rd. The S.E. Cor. Sec. 12 T. 14 N. R. 67 E. Mount Diablo Base and Meridian is a mound of stone from which a 4 x 4 ins. post has been removed. (See Note *)

Note * Jas. H. Marriott of Osceola testifies, that the mound of stone described as the S.E. Cor. of Sec. 12 formerly contained a 4" x 4" post marked S.E. Cor. Sec. 12 and that said post was placed at that point by W. B. Kinhardt and himself at the time of Mr. Kinhardt's survey made under Special Instructions dated Sept. 1893.
