INSTRUMENT.

This Survey was made with a Young & Sons transit. The courses were deflected from a meridian established by Polaris observation at Cor. No. 1.

The distances were measured with a 660 ft. Lufkin steel tape.

REPORT.

The S. W. Cor. Sec. 33, T. 2 S., R. 43 E., M. D. B. and M., is a porphyry stone, 5 x 10 x 12 ins. above ground, in mound of stone, marked with 2 notches on West edge and 4 notches on East edge.

Cor. No. 2, Hoboe No. 1 lode, unsurveyed, is a pine post 4 ins. square, extending 2 ft. above ground, marked Cor. No. 2, Hoboe No. 1 lode.

Cor. No. 5, Sur. No. 2243 New York No. 1 lode, is a porphyry stone, 6 x 8 x 8 ins. above ground, with mound of stone alongside, chiseled 5-2243.

Cor. No. 3-4, Sur. No. 2243, New York No. 1 and New York No. 2 lodes, is a pine post 4 ins. square, extending 1 ft. above ground, scribed 3-2243 and 4-2243.

I find the length of line 3-4 Sur. No. 2243 New York No. 1 lode to be 750.3 ft. instead of 749.6 ft. as approved. I also find the length of line 4-5 of the same Survey and lode to be 735.1 ft. instead of 734.7 ft. as approved.
