 REPORT

All of the lines of this survey and the sec. tie to the quarter sec. cor. to secs. 27 and 34 T. 13 N. R. 24 E., M. D. B. & M. were made direct upon the ground.

The quarter sec. cor. between secs. 27 and 34 T. 13 N. R. 24 E., M. D. B. & M. is a granite rock 12x10x8 ins. marked with a (x) on top and $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face, standing in a mound of rock.

I find the course and distance of the section line from the quarter sec. cor. to secs. 27 and 34 to the S. W. corner of sec. 27 T. 13 N. R. 24 E., M. D. B. & M. to be S. 88° 13' W. 2663.08 ft. instead of N. 89° 54' W. 2636.37 ft.

The coincident course and distances of contiguous surveys were found correct.
