

Survey No. 3126

Vesta lode, unsurveyed.

All corners of this lode are pine posts 4 ins. square, 3 ft. above ground, marked N.W. Cor. Vesta-S.W. Ohio and scribed 4-U.S.S. 56 N.E. Cor. Vesta, E. Side Angle stake Vesta, S.E. Cor. Vesta and S.W. Cor. Vesta respectively. From N.W. to N.E. Cor. is $S.77^{\circ}38'E.$ 504.3 ft. From N.E. Cor. to E.S. Angle stake is $S.24^{\circ}41'W.$ 854.76 ft. From E.S. Angle Stake to S.E. Cor. is $S.44^{\circ}38'50''W.$ 799.88 ft. From S.E. to S.W. Cor. is $N.77^{\circ}38'W.$ 504.3 ft.

Sur. No. 66 Joana lode.

Corners No's 2 and 3 were found in place and are cedar posts 4 ins. diameter, 2-1/2 ft. above ground, scribed 2-66 and 3-66 respectively. Line 2-3 is $S.56^{\circ}04'W.$ 1438.03 ft. instead of $S.55^{\circ}45'E.$ 1446.0 ft. as given in the approved field notes.

Sur. No. 2022 Florida lode.

Corners No's 1 and 8 were found in place and are cedar posts 4 ins. diameter, 2-1/2 ft. above ground, scribed 1-2022 and 8-2022 respectively. Line 8-1 is $N.75^{\circ}09'E.$ 1495.72 ft. instead of $N.77^{\circ}15'E.$ 1500.0 ft. as given in the approved field notes.

From Cor. No. 1 the N.E. Cor. Sec. 18 T. 16 N. R. 63 E. Mount Diablo Base and Meridian bears $N.67^{\circ}06'50''E.$ 1127.7 ft. instead of $N.67^{\circ}02'E.$ 1116.1 ft. as given in the approved field notes.

Sur. No. 1903 Blue Jay lode.

Corners No's 1 and 5 were found in place and are cedar posts 4 ins. in diameter, 4 ft. above ground in mounds of stone and scribed 1-1903 and 5-1903 respectively.

Line 5-1 is $S.84^{\circ}54'30''E.$ 492.25 ft. instead of $S.84^{\circ}31'E.$ 490.7 ft. as given in the approved field notes.

From Cor. No. 1 the N.E. Cor. Sec. 18 T. 16 N. R. 63 E. Mount Diablo Base and Meridian bears $N.73^{\circ}19'30''E.$ 868.23 ft. instead of $N.72^{\circ}57'30''E.$ 853.8 ft. as given in the approved field notes

Sur. No. 1903 Annex lode.

Corners No's 1-2-and 3 were found in place and are cedar posts 4 ins. in diameter 4 ft. above ground in mounds of stone, scribed 1-2-1903=1-2021; 2-1903 and 3-1903 respectively.

Line 2-3 is $N.49^{\circ}47'E.$ 1208.1 ft. instead of $N.49^{\circ}54'E.$ 1210.9 ft. Line 1-2 is $N.51^{\circ}45'W.$ instead of $N.51^{\circ}39'W.$ as given in approved field notes. From Cor. No. 1 the S.W. Cor. Sec. 8 T. 16 N. R. 63 E. M. D. B and M. bears $S.54^{\circ}10'10''W.$ 471.34 instead of $S.54^{\circ}11'W.$ 471.0 ft. as given in the approved field notes thereof.

Sur. No. 2021 Swifter ^{Junior} Lode.

Corners No's 5 and 6 were found in place and are cedar posts 6 ins. in diameter, 5 ft. above ground, scribed 5-2021 and 6-2021 respectively. Line 5-6 is $N.59^{\circ}46'E.$ 1328.0 ft. instead of $N.59^{\circ}21'E.$ 1320.6 ft. as given in the approved field notes.

The corner common to Sections 7-8-17 and 18 T. 16 N. R. 63 E. Mount Diablo base and Meridian is a lime stone, 6 x 12 ins. 20 ins. long, set in a mound of stone and chiseled IIII on the south and IIIII on the east sides and + on the top.
