No.10. Shaft, the center of which bears from Cor. No. 2, S. 12° 25' E. 502 ft., 5 x 7.5 ft. x 8.5 ft. deep in rock.

Value \$100.00.

No.11. Shaft, the center of which bears from Cor. No. 2, S. 15° 25' E. 499 ft., 4.5 x 7 ft. x 8 ft. deep in rock.

Value \$80.00.

This survey was made with a C. L. Berger & Sons Light Mountain Transit.

The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observation.

The distances were measured with 500 ft. and 5 ft. steel tapes.
