INSTRUMENT.

This survey was made with a Buff & Buff Mountain transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined from direct solar observations. the distances were measured with 660 ft and 6 ft. steel tapes.

NOTE.

The disagreement between these field notes and the location certificate with regard to the length of lode line, is due to errors in the latter.

REPORT.

The S.W.Cor. Sec.9 T.31 N.R.51 E. M+Diablo B and M is a porphyry stone 10 x 16 ins. showing 12 ins above ground chiseled with four marks on the south side and four marks on the east side, with mound of rocks on west side.
