✓ Lodes respectively, is a pine post 4 ins. square, showing 2-1/2 ft. above ground, in mound of earth and stone, scribed 3-4-2506.

✓ The corners of HYPATIA Lode, unsurveyed, are pine posts 4 ins. square showing 3 ft. above ground, in mound of earth and stone and marked N.W.Cor.HYPATIA, W.Side Cor.HYPATIA and S.W.Cor.HYPATIA.

✓ The corners of "ZZ" Lode, unsurveyed, are pine posts 4 ins. square showing 3 ft. above ground, in mound of earth and stone, and marked S.W.Cor.ZZ and S.E.Cor.ZZ.

✓ The E.1/4 Cor. Sec.34, T 3 N, R 42 E, Mt.D.B.and M. is a lava rock showing 6 inches above ground and chiseled 1/4.
