Other Improvements

An artesian well, 2 in. pipe, which bears from Gov. No. 2 Buck Springs mill site N. 0° 51' W. 340 ft. Said artesian well belongs to claimant herein.

An adobe house 15.9 x 15.9 ft., course of sides, west, the S.E. Cor. of which bears from Gov. No. 2 Buck Springs mill site N. 36° 15' W. 82.3 ft. Said adobe house belongs to claimant herein.

An artesian well, 3 in. pipe, which bears from Gov. No. 2 Buck Springs mill site N. 57° 23' W. 138.5 ft. Said artesian well belongs to claimant herein.

An adobe house 15.9 x 17 ft., course of long sides, west, the S.E. Cor. of which bears from Gov. No. 3 Buck Springs mill site S. 40° 31' W. 353.1 ft. Said adobe house belongs to claimant herein.

Instrument.

This survey was made with a Berger No. 4 Light Mountain Transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by a direct solar observation. The distances were measured with a 500 ft. steel tape.

Report.

The Gov. to Secs. 26, 27, 34 and 35, T. 13 N. R. 24 E., Mt. Diablo Band W., is a quartzite stone 8 x 12 ins., 14 ins. above ground in mound of stones, marked with 2 notches on east edge and 1 notch on south edge.
