

SURVEY NO. 3187.

I N S T R U M E N T.

This Survey was made with a Buff and Buff Light Mountain Transit.

The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct observation upon the sun.

The distances were measured with 100 ft., and 500 ft. steel tapes.

R E P O R T.

The N. W. Cor. Sec. 26, T. 2 S., R. 42 E., is a stone 3 x 6 ins., 12 ins., above ground, chiseled with 2 notches on the E. and 2 notches on the S. faces.

Cor. No. 4, Sur. No. 2598, Last Dollar lode, is a post 4 x 4 ins., 2 ft. above a mound of earth and stone, scribed 4-2598.

Cor. No. 4, Sur. No. 3002, Camp Bird lode, is a post 4 x 4 ins., 2 ft. above a mound of earth and stone, scribed 4-3002.

OTHER IMPROVEMENTS.

A shaft 4 x 6 ft., 23 ft. deep, the center of which bears from Cor. No. 2, N. 57° 17' W. 229.4 ft. Claimant unknown.
