A house, the northerly corner of which bears from Corner No. 3 Eagle lode, S 30°W, 462 feet.

20 X 30 feet, course of long side N 45° E.

Claimant unknown

A cabin, the northerly corner of which bears from Corner No. 3 Eagle Lode S 21°40' W, 495 feet.

18 X 20 feet, course of long side N 45° E.

Claimant unknown

INSTRUMENT

This survey was made with a Lietz Transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by solar observations. The distances were measured with 6 foot and 330 foot steel tapes.

NOTE

The disagreement between these field notes and the amended location certificate of the Blue Jay lode, with regard to the distance from Corner No. 1 Blue Jay lode to Corner No. 3, Survey No. 3207 White Horse lode, is due to error in the latter.

REPORT

The S. W. Corner, Section 20, T 27 N., R 48 E., M. D. B. and M. is a cedar post 3 X 3 inches set in a mound of stone and marked with 5 notches on the east face and 2 notches on the south face

Corners Nos. 2, 3 and 4, Survey No. 3207, White Horse lode, are pine posts, 4 X 4 inches and set in mounds of earth and stone. Scried 2-3207 and 3-3207, and 4-3207, respectively.

The courses and distances as given in the approved field notes thereof were found to be correct.

I made diligent search for a corner of the public ^{land} survey nearer than the S. W. Corner, Section 20, T 27 N., R. 48 E., M. D. B. and M., but found none.
