INSTRUMENT

This survey was made with a Lietz Transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by solar observations. The distances were measured with 6 foot and 330 foot steel tapes.

REPORT

The S. W. Corner Section 20, T. 27 N., R 48 E., is a cedar post 3 X 3 inches, set in a mound of stone and marked with 5 notches on the east face and 2 notches on the south face.

I made diligent search for corners of the public land survey nearer than the S. W. Corner of Section 20, T 27 N., R. 48 E., M. D. B. and M., but found none.
