✓ LOCATION.

This claim is located in the S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ and S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 1, and N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ and N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 12, T. 3 S., R. 44 E., Mt. Diablo Base and Meridian.

✓ EXPENDITURE OF FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS.

No improvements returned herewith.

✓ INSTRUMENT.

This survey was made with a Berger & Sons Light Mountain Transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct observation on the sun. The distances were measured with 100 ft. and 500 ft. steel tapes.

✓ REPORT.

The S. W. Cor. of Sec. 36, T. 2 S., R. 44 E., Mt. Diablo B. and M., is a black granite rock, showing 4 x 6 x 10 ins. above ground, chiseled 1 notch on E. side and 5 notches on W. side.
