

Survey No. 3249

A trench, the south end of which bears from Cor. No.1, S.73°E. 230 ft. 2 ft. wide, 2 ft. deep, running north 60 ft.

Claimant unknown.

A trench, the south end of which bears from Cor. No.1, N.25°E. 260 ft. 2½ ft. wide, 7 ft. deep, running N.22°E. 60 ft.

Claimant unknown.

✓ INSTRUMENT.

This survey was made with a Berger & Sons No.6 transit.

The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observation.

The distances were measured with a 500 ft. steel tape.

✓ NOTE.

The disagreements between these field notes and the location certificate are due to errors in the latter.

✓ REPORT.

The S.E. Cor. Sec. 1, T.3 S., R. 42 E.M.D.M. to which connection is herein given, consists of a stone 7x9x6 ins. above ground chiselled 1 notch on the north, 5 notches on the south, and x on top.

The N.E. Cor. Big Swede lode (unsurveyed) consists of a post 4 ins. square, showing 3½ ft. above the ground in mound marked N.E. Cor. Big Swede lode.

Cor. No.3, Sur. No. 2388 Porphyry lode, consists of a post 4 ins. square, showing 2½ ft. above ground in mound, scribed 3-2388.

The North side corner Denver lode (unsurveyed) consists of a post 4 ins. square, showing 3½ ft. above ground in mound marked N. side Cor. Denver lode.
