Location.

The Triangle and Big Dick Lodes are situated in the N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec, 9 . The Senior Lode is situated partly in the N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ and the S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec, 9 and in the N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec, 10 T.28 N. R 47 E. M.D.M. The intersections with the section lines are given from the Field Notes of survey thereof on file in the Office of the Surveyor general. The corner to Sec's 3-4-9 and 10 was the nearest existing corner of the public surveys which could be found.

Instrument.

This survey was made with a Gurley Light Mountain Solar Transit. The courses were deflected from a true Meridian as determined by a direct bearing taken on Polaris at West Elongation, and an Azimuth of $1,33^{\circ}$ deflected to the East; the distances were measured with 25 ft, and 500 ft, steel tapes.

The disagreement between these field notes and the location certificates are due to want of exactness and errors in the latter.

Report.

The stone Monument on summit of hill S.W. from town of Tenabo to which bearings are given, was erected by the Miners of the District for the purpose of having a common point from which to describe their locations, and is called by them a Mineral Monument, and consists of a pine post 6 ins square 6 ft, long standing in mound of rock 5 ft, base 4 ft, high. The cor, to Sec's 3-4-9 and 10 is a granite boulder 8 x 9 x 10 ins, marked with 3 notches on the East side and 5 notches on the south side and is set 5 ins in the ground with mound along side 4 ins above the general level of the ground, the appearance being that said mound had been at one time higher and wasted away by the action of the elements.
