

SURVEY No. 3267.

REPORT.

The S. E. Cor. Sec. 5 T. 6 S. R. 41 E. is a stone 4 ins. square standing 0.4 ft. above mound of stone 2.5 ft. diameter and 12 ins. high.

Cor. No. 2 Sur. No. 2427 Contention lode is a pine post 4 ins. square standing 2.3 ft. above mound of earth and stone properly scribed.

Cor. No. 3 Sur. No. 2427 Contention lode was found lying on ground approximately on line 4-1 Gold Coin lode of this survey about 200 ft. from Cor. No. 1.

Cor. No. 3 Sur. No. 2383 Colorado lode is a pine post 4 ins. square standing $2\frac{1}{2}$ ft above mound of earth and stone, painted white and marked U. S. S. 2383 Cor. No. 3

I find lines 1-2, 2-3 and 3-4 Sur. No. 2383 Colorado lode to be N. $36^{\circ} 57'$ E. 297. ft., N. $28^{\circ} 56'$ E. 296.6 ft., N. $77^{\circ} 49'$ W. 1473.5 ft. instead of N. $31^{\circ} 30'$ E. 300. ft., N. $29^{\circ} 05'$ E. 300. ft., N. $77^{\circ} 40'$ W. 1459. ft. respectively, as reported. Also tie of Sur. No. 2383 Colorado lode from Cor. No. 1 to Section Corner to be S. $46^{\circ} 42'$ E. 1274.2 ft. instead of S. $46^{\circ} 51'$ E. 1254.6 ft. as approved.
