

## I N S T R U M E N T .

This survey was made with a Dietzgen Mountain and Mining Transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observations.

The distances were measured with 660 ft. and 100 ft. steel tapes.

## N O T E .

The disagreements between these field notes and the amended location certificate are due to errors in the latter.

## R E P O R T .

The tie is given to the N. W. Cor. Sec. 2, T. 3 S., R. 42 E., M. D. B. and M., because the S. W. Cor. could not be found.

The N. W. Cor. Sec. 2, T. 3 S., R. 42 E., M. D. B. and M., is a basalt stone, 12 x 12 x 13 ins. above ground, marked with two notches on the east, and four notches on the west, with a nail in the top.

Cor. No. 5, Sur. No. 3138 B, Low Grade Mill Site, is a pine post, 4 ins square showing 2 1/2 ft. above ground, in mound of earth and stone, scribed 5-3138 B.

Cor. No. 6, Sur. No. 3138 B, Low Grade Mill Site, is a pine post, 4 ins. square, showing 18 ins. above ground in mound of earth and stone, scribed 6-3138 B.

Cor. No. 1, Sur. No. 3139, Box Canyon lode, is a basalt rock in place, 20 x 24 x 18 ins. above ground, chiseled 1-3139, with a cross (x) on top.

Cor. No. 2, Sur No. 3139, Box Canyon lode, is a pine post, 4 ins. square showing 18 ins. above ground, in mound of earth and stone, scribed 2-3139.

Cor. No. 3, Sur. No. 2329, Victor lode, is a porphyry stone 5 x 12 x 8 ins. above ground, in mound of earth and stone, chiseled 3-2329, with a cross (x) on top.

N. E. Cor. Witch Placer, unsurveyed, is a pine post 4 ins. square standing 2 1/2 ft. above ground in mound of stone, marked N. E. Corner Witch Placer.
