

Consists of a pine post 6 ins square, showing 5 ft above the ground, in mound of stone 3 ft high with 6 ft base, Scribed U. S. L. M No 197 on north side. It is located on the highest point on Sentinel Mountain

The West $\frac{1}{4}$ Cor of Sec 18 T 11. S R 47 E M. D. B. and M. Consists of a Rhyolite stone about 7 x 10 ins. Chiseled $\frac{1}{4}$ on the east face firmly set and extending about 14 ins above the ground with mound of stone alongside,
