No. 2 A shaft 4 x 6 ft. 53 ft. deep and drift 4 x 6 ft. 40 ft. long. The shaft bears from Cor. No. 4 N. 32° 45' E. 500 ft. From the bottom of shaft the drift runs N. 2° 00' W. 40 ft. to face.

## OTHER IMPROVEMENTS.

A shaft 3½ x 7 ft. 10 ft. deep, which bears from Cor. No. 4 N. 70° 15' E. 217 ft. Claimant unknown.

## INSTRUMENT.

This survey was made with a C. L. Berger and Son's Light Mountain Transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observations. The distances were measured with 5 ft. and 500 ft. steel tapes.

## NOTE.

The disagreements between these field notes and the location certificate are due to errors in the latter.

## REPORT.

The N.W. Cor. Sec. 25 T. 2 S. R. 42 E. M. D. B. and M. is a stone 9 x 9 inches showing 7 inches above ground in mound of stone, with 2 notches on the South and 1 notch on the East edges. cross (x) on top.

Cor. No's. 2-3 Sur. No. 2850 Monroe and Jefferson lodes is a pine post 4 ins. square, standing 2½ ft. above ground, scribed 2-3-2850.
