Instrument

This survey was made with a Guley
Light Mountain Transit.

The courses were deflected from the true
meridian as determined by direct so-
lar observations.

The distances were measured with 50
and 400 ft. steel tapes.

Description of Corners

The 14 section corner between Sections
33rd and 34 T. 31 N. R. 53 E. of the Mount
Diablo base and meridian is a
quartz rock 20x20x15 ins. above ground,
marked with 14 on N. face, with mound
of stone around same.

Note: After diligent search I was
unable to find a corner of the public
surveys nearer the claim than the 14
section corner between Sections 33rd and 34
T. 31 N. R. 53 E. of the Mount Diablo base
and meridian.
