The vertical discovery shaft the center of which bears N 17°20' E 356 feet from corner No 1 ,5 by 6 feet ,8 feet deep in solid rock ,value \$110.00

No 2

An open cut the mouth of which bears N19°40'E 327 feet from corner No 1 ,18 feet long ,with 11 feet face and having a width of 9.5 feet ,course S88°10'E, in solid rock ,value \$200.00

No 3

An open cut the mouth of which bears N 22°41'E 628 feet from corner No 1 ,3 feet wide ,with 10 feet face ,35 feet long, in solid rock ,course N 88° E ,value \$150.00

No 4

A tunnel the portal of which bears N23°10'E 698 feet from corner No 1 ,5by 6½ feet ,30 feet long in solid rock ,course S79°E,value \$340.00

Total value of improvements \$800.00

## INSTRUMENT

This survey was made with a Wand L.E. Gurley Mountain Transit. The courses were deflected from a true Meridian ,determined from an observation on Polaris at its Eastern Elongation on September 20-1907; the distances were measured with a 300 feet steel tape ,made by Justus Roe and Sons
