INSTRUMENT.

This survey was made with a C.L. Berger transit..
The courses were deflected from the true meridian as
determined by direct solar observation. The distances
were measured with a 300 ft. steel tape, graduated
in feet and tenths.

The section corner common to sections 10, 11, 14 and
