The Witness Corner to S. E. Cor. Sec. 27, T. 16 N.

R. 43 E., of the M. D. B. and M. to which connection is given, is a slate stone, 6x6 ins., showing 6 ins. above the surface of the ground, with mound of stone alongside, marked W.C. with 1 notch on S. face and 2 notches on E. face.

Cor. No. 3, Sur. No. 1847, Horton lode, is a slate stone, 8x10 ins., showing 12 ins. above the surface of the ground, marked U. S. S. 1847-3.

Cor. No. 4, Sur. No. 1847, Horton lode, is a slate stone, 4x22 ins., showing 20 ins. above the surface of the ground, marked U. S. S. 1847-4.

I find the course of line 3-4, Sur. No. 1847, Horton lode, to be S.  $37^{\circ}18'$  W., 548.51 ft. instead of S.  $39^{\circ}49'$  W., 600 ft. as approved.

I find the bearing and distance of the section line between the E. 1/4 Cor. and the S. E. Cor. of Sec. 27, T. 16 N., R. 43 E., of the M. D. B. and M. to be N.  $0^{\circ}05'$  W., 2599.26 ft. instead of N.  $0^{\circ}01'$  W. 2640 ft. as approved.

NOTE: The disagreement between these field notes and the amended location of the Ora Anna and Ora Fino lodes with regard to the courses of the lode lines and boundary lines are due to errors in the latter.
