

## REPORT.

All lines of this survey of the Golden Star and Grand Deposit lodes and their respective ties to the N. W. Cor. Sec. 25, T. 16 N., R. 43 E. of the M. D. B. and M. were made direct upon the ground.

The N. W. Cor. Sec. 25, T. 16 N., R. 43 E., of the M. D. B. and M. to which connection is given, is a slate stone, 6x6 ins., standing 8 ins. above ground, with mound of stone alongside, marked with 1 notch on E. face and 2 notches on S. face.

## INSTRUMENT.

This survey was made with a Lietz transit, No. 1349. The distances were measured with a 650 ft. Lufkin steel tape.

The courses were deflected from the True Meridian as determined by direct Solar Observations.

NOTE: The disagreements between these field notes and the Amended Certificates of the Golden Star and Grand Deposit lodes with regard to the bearings of the lode lines and boundary lines, and the length of the lode line of the Golden Star lode are due to errors in the latter.
