REPORT

The corner of sections 25, 30, 31 and 36, Townships 13 N Ranges 24 and 25 East of Mount Diablo Base and Meridian is an eruptive stone 18 inches long, 8 by 10 inches in diameter, in a mound of stones, chiseled with one groove on the South and five grooves on the North sides, and the corner of sections 19, 24, 25 and 30, Townships 13 N Ranges 24 and 25 East of Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, is a Granite stone 16 inches long 6 by 8 inches ~~diameter~~, surrounded by a mound of stones, chiseled with two grooves on the South and four grooves on the North sides.

After diligent search the quarter section corner between sections 25 and 30 Townships 13 N Ranges 24 and 25 East of Mount Diablo Base and Meridian could not be found. The East line of section 25, Township 13 N, Range 24 East of Mount Diablo Base and Meridian was run and measured by me from the corner of sections 25, 30, 31 and 36, to the corner of sections 19, 24, 25 and 30, and all intersections with claim lines noted.

Corner No 2 survey No 2913, ~~the~~ Yellowstone lode is a Fir post showing $2\frac{1}{2}$ feet above the ground in mound of earth size of post 4 by 6 inches, scribed 2-2913

The S.E., S.W. and N.W. corners of the Daniel lode ^{unsurveyed} are fir posts showing $3\frac{1}{2}$ feet above the ground, 4 inches square set in mound of earth and stone, marked S.E., S.W and N.W corner of Daniel lode respectively.

✓ Corner No 1 survey No 37, Bluestone No 1 lode, which is also corner No 1 survey No 2913 the Chaska lode, is a fir post showing $2\frac{1}{2}$ feet above the ground, 4 by 6 inches square set in mound of earth, scribed 1-37 and 1-2913.

✓ Corner No 4 survey No 2913, ~~the~~ Minnehaha lode is a fir ^{post} showing $2\frac{1}{2}$ feet above the ground, 4 by 6 inches square scribed 4-2913.

The S.E. and S.W corners of the Katie lode, unsurveyed
