✓ REPORT.

The Cor. to Secs. 27, 28, 33 and 34, T. 8 N., R. 35 E. of the M. D. B. and M. consists of a rock, 20x8x9 ins. marked with 1 notch on S. edge and 3 notches on E. edge. Rock is firmly planted in earth and broken stone, with mound of rock alongside.

The N. E. Cor. of the N. E. 1/4, Sec. 6, T. 7 N., R. 35 E., of the M. D. B. and M. is marked by a monument of rock, 3 ft. high, 3 ft. at base, containing 3 pieces of cedar shingles, each marked N. E. Cor. N. E. 1/4, Sec. 6, T. 7 N., R. 35 E., of the M.D.B. and M.

The N.E. Cor. of Sec. 33, T. 8 N., R. 35 E., of the M. D. B. and M. was the nearest corner that could be identified.
