and the respective ties to the S.W. Cor. Sec. 35, T. 3
N., R. 42 E. of the M. D. B. and M. to which connection
is given were made direct upon the ground.

The S.W. Cor. Sec. 35,T. 3 N., R. 42 E., of the M. D. B. and M. is a stone, 6x8 ins., showing 8 ins. above surface of the ground, with mound of stone alongside, marked with 4 no tohes on W. and 2 notches on E. faces.

The .W. 1/4 Cor. Sec. 35, T. 3 N., R. 42 E., of the M.D.B. and M. is a stone 6x14 ins., showing 18 ins. above surface of the ground, with mound of stone alongside, chiseled 1/4.

I find the bearing and distance of the section line between the S.W. Cor. Sec. 35 and the W. 1/4 Cor. Sec. 35, T. 3 N., R. 42 E. of the M.D.B. and M. to be N. 0°19' W. 2616.75 ft. instead of North 2640 ft. as approved.

Cor. No. 4, Sur. No. 2024, West End lode, is a stone 6 ins. square, showing 6 ins. above surface of the ground, chiseled X-4-2024.

Cors. Nos. 3 and 4, Sur. No. 2600, Eureka lode, are pine posts, 4 ins. square, showing 2.5 ft. above surface of the ground, scribed 3-2600 and 4-2600, respectively.

Cor. No. 4, Sur. No. 2600, Sunset lode, is a pine post, 4 ins. square, showing 2.5 ft. above surface of the ground, scribed 4-2600.

The following corners are destroyed, their position being determined from the official record, and are shown in accordance therewith:

Cors. Nos. 3 and 5, Sur. No. 2024, West End lode.

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
