

Survey No. 3497.

Instrument.

This Survey was made with a
Nietzgen Light Mountain Transit.

The courses were deflected
from the true Meridian as deter-
mined by observation with a
Saegmüller Solar Attachment.

The distances were measured
with a 100 ft. Steel tape.

Report.

The description of the N. W.
Cor of Sec. 34 T. 25 N. R. 28 E
of Mt. Diablo Base and Meridian,
or the Corner Common to Sections
27, 28, 33, and 34, is as follows:

A Pine Post 2.3 ft from ground
surrounded by mound of Earth
with White Flag by its side and
close thereto, to locate same in
the distance, identified by four
pits North, South, East, and West
of Post: No marks visible.

The description of the U. S.
L. M. No. 1 is as follows:

A Pine post 4" x 4", 7½ ft
above the ground, surrounded
by stones, the base being 6 ft in
diameter and 4 ft high: the
post being 3½ ft above said
stones; said post being set
one foot in the ground and scribed
U. S. L. M. No. 1.
