

Survey No. 3506

From station No. 5, the main road to Currier Wells bears N. $9^{\circ} 20' W.$ 1350.0 ft.

Instrument.

This survey was made with a Frauth Rev. Light Mt. Transit. The courses were deflected from a true meridian as determined by direct solar observations. The distances were measured with 300-ft. and 6-ft. steel tapes.

Notes.

The disagreements between these field notes and the amended certificates of the lodes of this claim are due to errors in the latter and to the drawing in of corners.

Adjoining claim, the Annex Fraction lode, owner and exact boundaries of which are unknown.

Report.

N. S. L. M. No. 170 is a pine post 6x6 ins. by 8 ft. high, set in mound of stone and scribed N. S. L. M. No. 170.

Cor. No. 5, S. M. No. 2843, Bell Fountain lode is a pine post 4x4 ins. by 4 1/2 ft. showing 8 ft. above ground in mound of stone and earth, and scribed 5-2843.

The common corner of Sps. 11 and 12 S. Rgs. 45 and 46 E., M. S. M. is a rhyolite
